

## December 2007 Graduating Class Placement/Return Summary

The December 2007 graduating class was comprised of 176 graduates. The overall response rate was 92.0%.

87 of the graduates were international students. 54 returned to their home country or region within the sixty day period after graduation, the legal amount of time they may stay after graduation without changing visa status.

The intl. graduate return rate, based on 100% response for international graduates, was 62.1%.

113 graduates ( 64.2%) of the class stated they were seeking employment after graduation.

The placement rate (of those seeking employment) was 67.3%. 76 of the 113 people had secured employment by the time of graduation.

22 of the graduates (12.5%) stated they were seeking graduate school admission as the next destination after BYU Hawaii.

Our graduate school acceptance rate is 9.1%.

2 of the 22 grads had been accepted into graduate school.

27 graduates or 15.34% indicated their next destination as "other". This category includes full-time homemaker, full time missionary service, teacher certification programs, or other training/education NOT graduate school.

14 graduates (8.0%) did not provide information about their next destination.
